

Cherokee Nation and its Businesses

- Largest American Indian tribe
- More than 330,000 tribal citizens
- 11,000 employees, most of whom are Cherokee, in 48 states
- Economic impact in northeast Oklahoma – \$1.55 billion, directly or indirectly supporting more than 15,600 jobs
- Tribal jurisdiction encompasses all or part of 14 northeast Oklahoma counties
- Sovereign tripartite government with executive, judicial and legislative branches
- All Cherokee Nation companies hire tribally owned and staffed vendors and subcontractors when possible
- Cherokee Nation Businesses, board-governed holding company for Cherokee Nation's companies:
 - 2015 revenues - \$925 million
 - 2015 profits - \$112 million
 - 35% of net income supports services for Cherokee citizens
 - 65% of net income reinvested in Cherokee businesses - training, job creation and self sufficiency
 - 35 companies
 - 18+ are MBE, 8(a) and/or HUBZone certified
 - 40+ years experience
